Fantastic Family Fundraising!

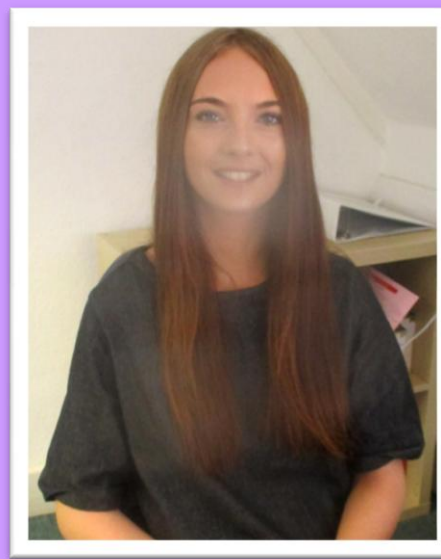

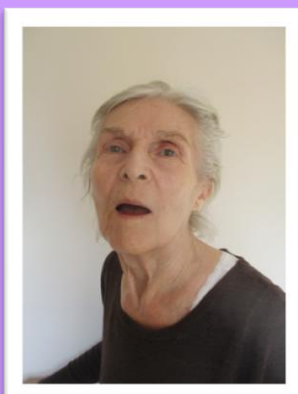
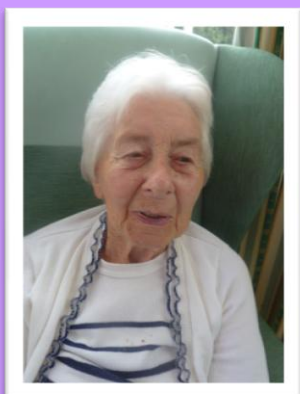
